An international workshop for 8 days was held with the participation of 30 students from SIT and 13 students from Vienna University of Technology. The theme was "Urban Planning, Design, Transportation, Tourism and Area Management. Six mixed teams of students from the two schools were organized to conduct site surveys and prepare proposals in six different target areas in Tokyo, including commercial and residential areas. During the period, almost all the students visited the headquarter office of a major real estate company and received a briefing on urban development in central Tokyo. This was followed by a tour of urban parks and historical structures in the city center.

At the final presentation, each team made a unique proposal, and the results were satisfactory for the short period of time. In the process, students actively communicated and fostered friendships. Although some of SIT students' English skills were a little lacking, they all worked very hard and the experience was very valuable. We look forward to the continued efforts of the students and the continued development of this program.
